

Health and Safety Policy Statement Health and Safety at Work etc ACT 1974

Our statement of general policy is:

- To provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities
- To consult with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety
- To provide and maintain safe plant and equipment
- To ensure safe handling and use of substances
- To provide information, instruction and supervision for our employees
- To ensure all employees are competent to do their tasks, and to give them adequate training
- To prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health
- To maintain safe and healthy working conditions
- To review and revise this policy at regular intervals

<u>Duties of our Employees</u>

Every employee of St Mirren Football Club has a duty to take reasonable care for the health and safety of themselves and of other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions at work. Employees also have a duty to cooperate with their employer so far as is necessary to enable the Club to perform its civil and statutory obligations.
